The discoloured Huntingdonshire sign has now been removed from the village sign.

Eleanor Jack presented her chair's report for the past year - see appendix A


It is currently under discussion to get the new Greensand signs attached to the existing signage in the village. The traffic engineer is willing to discuss this but the legal department of highways want to charge £500 just to assess the situation. Councillor Julie Wisson will Email the highways department to investigate further.

5. County Councillor's Report

County Councillor Julie Wisson gave her annual report.

The decision for the final route of the A428 upgrade was made during the year and followed the route preferred by the local councils - there is an update meeting next week

The East-West Rail Consultation - The county council supports the southernmost route through Bassingbourn and the Mayor is pushing for a link between Cambridge, Camborne & St Neots.


6. District Councillors' Report
